Dear Ones,

For many Christians, March 2 is the day the season of Lent begins, known as Ash Wednesday. In many western Christian churches Lent is the period of time from Ash Wednesday, through Holy Saturday, the day before Easter. Lenten practices and devotions vary from denomination to denomination, some Christians do not observe it at all. Lent is not talked about in the Bible and so the practices we observe during this time come from adaptations of Jewish observances and early Christian tradition. One commonality among Lenten practices is fasting or abstaining from something we commonly eat or do during the rest of the year. Has someone ever asked you, "What are you giving up for Lent?" The thought behind this is so that we might practice selfdiscipline, prepare our whole selves in a special way to connect more deeply with our God. Lenten practices also include meditating more, praying more, engaging in acts of charity, and the like. Lent is a journey, slowing down, being where we are, moving step by step, breath by breath, with Jesus. I have a suggestion for this Lenten season. Perhaps we can "give up" being hard on ourselves and one another? Perhaps we can "give up" trying to be perfect and expecting perfection from others? Can we give up guilt and regret and anger and put our whole selves into the loving, mighty, and gracious hands of God? Can we try, day by day to turn over any control we try to take, any burden we carry, and trust that God will see us through? I look forward to this Lenten journey with you, my siblings in Christ. Please join us for a special Ash Wednesday service on Wednesday, March 2 at 3:30 pm in the chapel, in lieu of Bible Study. Every Sunday we gather at 1:30 pm for prayers and the hearing of God's word.
