Dear Ones,

I suppose I am a traditionalist when it comes to fall, and so now that September is here, autumn REALLY has arrived.

The fall is a mixed bag...some folks dislike it because it means that winter is coming; some people relish in the change, looking forward to cooler temperatures and the splendor of the changing leaves that we experience in Western Pennsylvania.

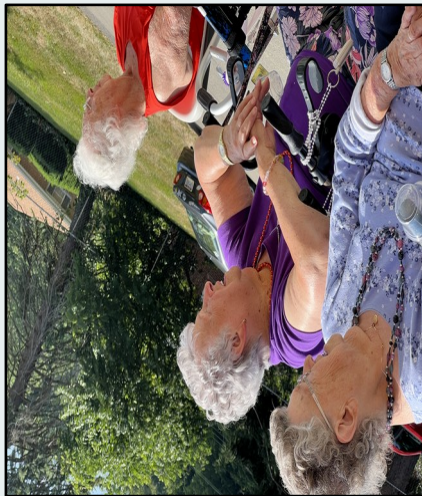

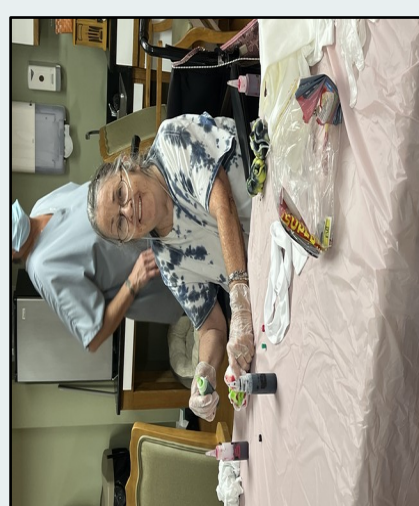
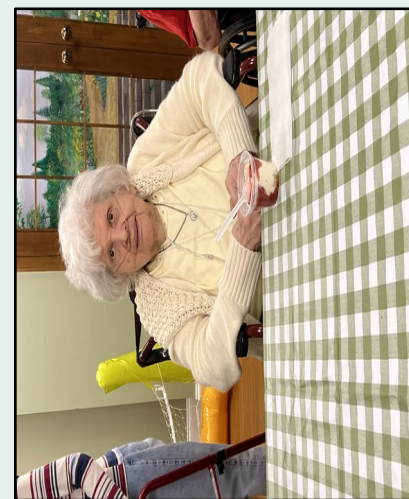
